Vacation Care Program

Vacation Care is open from 7.00am to 6.00pm during the holidays. We are not open on public holidays. The cost is \$48.00 a day which is subsidised by childcare benefit.

Children need to be booked in, prior to the holidays to ensure their place. Bookings made after the due date or during the holidays will only be accepted if a place is available. Children need to be at school by 9.00am if they are booked into an excursion, so that they don't miss the bus.

If children are booked in for an excursion they must attend they cannot change their mind on the day as we turn down other children that would like to book in and attend the excursion. **Due to the increasing number of children doing this as well as children that are booking in for an excursion & not attending on the day, we have now introduced a system once a child has not attended on the day of the excursion or has changed their mind on the day 3 times, without any notice or cancellation from a parent they will no longer be given first option to book into any of the excursions for the remainder of the current holiday period and following holiday period.**

Parents and caregivers need to sign their children in and out of Vacation Care via the attendance sheet. **Notification of any cancellations for both weeks of the Vacation Care break must be made before 5pm, Friday 12th April 2019. Cancellations after this date will incur a full absence fee. This amount will be less your CCS% and will be recorded as an "A" absence fee.**

Children are required to bring their lunch and recess every day. On excursion days children are allowed to bring spending money to purchase snacks and drinks **NOT LUNCH**. If you would like childcare providers to look after this money please send it in a purse or wallet that is clearly labelled with the child's name.

Dress Code

- Shoulders need to be covered
- Knee length pants or skirts/dresses
- No thongs or scuffs
- Closed in shoes or sandals with heel straps, to hold them on.

Children who are not dressed as outlined will be required to play indoors.
